Containing Malicious Projections in Supervision

This training forms part of the 10-day supervision training, which is a route to the Certificate and Diploma in Clinical Supervision.

An Overview of the Topic:

Malicious projects are an attack on moral goodness. They contain "...wicked or mischievous intentions or motives; are wrongful and done intentionally without just cause or excuse..."

This workshop will focus on understanding what happens to the supervisee when they are the focus of this kind of attack and approaches to working with the projections in order to understand the energy driving them and how to work with that energy.

The first 2 days of this course will explore the theoretic input, group discussion and experiential exercise. Day 3 will focus on supervised supervision.
